Researchers considering submitting a paper are advised to discuss this with the theme and work package leads or supervisors.

Priority will be given for talks for which data has already been collected, and those planning to present their talk at major conferences. However, submissions are welcome for work that is either planned, or currently in progress.

Prizes will be given for the best Ph.D. talk, and the best postdoc talk.

Abstracts should be a maximum of 500 words, with a single supplementary page for figures, tables, and references.
